Kingswood College was established in March 1894. While 2014 marked our 120th year, we are already planning the celebration of our 125th year in 2019! Kingswood started off as a boys' school, but today, it is one of the country's top co-educational Methodist schools, with an honour roll including some of South Africa's most prominent sportsmen, academics and business leaders. It is a school that prides itself on being a place where everyone finds their niche, and where pupils thrive in a family-oriented school community.

Kicking off the journey to our 125th celebrations was the launch of the 125@KC Campaign in March 2014, a 5-year fundraising campaign which will involve all Kingswoodians, friends of the College and supporters in the challenge to assist Kingswood in securing our financial sustainability for the future. The five strategic funds being targeted are: Facilities, Pupil Enhancement, Teacher Enhancement, Scholarships and Bursaries and Community Engagement and Learning Funds.

The Kingswood College Centenary Trust was registered as an independent entity in February 2001 as part of a proposed solution aimed at addressing the financial challenges that the independent schooling sector faces. The purpose of the Trust is to generate financial support for the school, and, in so doing this ensures that the strategic objectives of Kingswood College are met. Coupled with the Scholarship and Bursary Trust registered in December 2009, these form the basis of Kingswood's financial stability.
